Lines of the Small and Medium Blankets

IF YOU ARE GOING TO MAKE A SMALL OR MEDIUM BLANKET YOU DO NOT MAKE THE LINES ON THE SIDE OF BLOCKS 15 AND 16!!!!

Lines of the Large Blanket

After Block	Next to Block	On Top of Block	Bind Off Row
13		13	Yes
14	13/14		NO
15	15	14/15	Yes
16	16	16	Yes



Foundation Row Block 13

Attach your yarn on the right corner on the bottom of your work. Chain 30. Picking up your loops and work the connection (32 loops).

Foundation Row Block 14

Attach your yarn on the right corner of the line above Block 13. Pick up 30 loops and make the connection (32 loops).



Foundation Row

Attach your yarn to the right corner on the bottom of the line next to Blocks 13/14. Chain 13 and make the connection (15 loops).

This block shows my love of Celtic knots. We are only making cables, but there are 3 different kind of cables included in one design. It isn't hard to make, just watch how many stitches you have to cross carefully. The TKS in this pattern is ALWAYS in front of your work.

Foundation Row

Small or Medium Blankets:

Attach yarn to the back of the border stitch of Block 15.

Large Blanket:

Skip 4 loops of the vertical line and attach to the back of the next stitch of the line on Block 15.

Reminder to always count your rows on the right side of your work. The border stitches create a nice V for every row which is easy to see and count.
